Brief





- The Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi launched 'Customized Crash Course program for Covid 19 Frontline workers on 18th June 2021. The aim of this program is to train about one lakh frontline workers.
- Mr. Dharmendra Pradhan, Hon'ble Minister for Skill Development & Entrepreneurship and Education, (then Union Minister for Petroleum) was also present during the launch of the Covid Courses.
- The training will be imparted to Covid warriors in six customized job roles such as Home Care Support, Basic Care Support, Advanced Care Support, Emergency Care Support, Sample Collection Support, and Medical Equipment Support. This will include fresh skilling as well as upskilling of those who have some training in this type of work.
- The first month training to be conduced at the training institute/Healthcare Center followed by 3 Months on the job training, mandatorily at Healthcare Organization for each COVID crash course.
